dente della Società Europea di Chirurgia Cranio-Maxillo-Facciale che ha come "mission" anche quella di promuovere la conoscenza della disciplina nei Paesi dell'Est.

Per le particolari condizioni della paziente è stato approntato un team multidisciplinare che ha compreso: il chirurgo plastico (Prof. Carlo Riberti), l'otorinolaringoiatra (Prof. Antonio Pastore), il neurochirurgo (Dr. Michele Cavallo e Dr.ssa Antonia Lorenzin), l'oftalmologo (Prof. Adolfo Sebastiani). Altri specialisti tra cui il neuro-

diologo e l'anestesista hanno completato lo studio preoperatorio, al fine di potere assicurare le migliori cure alla paziente. Anche il coordinamento del personale infermieristico è stato di fondamentale importanza. Il 9 ottobre è stato eseguito un primo intervento. L'operazione è durata circa 6 ore ed è stata eseguita oltre che dal Dr. Clauser, dal Dr. Stefano Mandrioli e dal Dr. Manlio Galì. Il decorso postoperatorio è stato regolare e la paziente è rientrata a Bucarest dopo 5 giorni. I contatti successivi sono avvenuti via e-mail. Nel mese di gennaio 2008 seguirà un secondo intervento, molto complesso, di ricostruzione cranio-orbita-facciale che è durerà oltre 12 ore, e ha visto ancora la collaborazione tra il chirurgo cranio-maxillo-facciale, il neurochirurgo e il gruppo di anestesisti coordinato dalla Dr.ssa Aurelia Guberti.

Questo intervento ha rappresentato l'inizio di un'internazionalità dell'Unità Operativa di Chirurgia Cranio-Maxillo-Facciale di Ferrara che nei prossimi mesi vedrà il trasferimento di altri pazienti dell'Est Europa oltre che da nazioni come Danimarca e Libano.

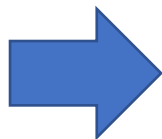

The rational behind



- Many of those affected by a **rare or complex condition** do not have **access to diagnosis** and high-quality treatment.
- Expertise and **specialist knowledge** may be **scarce** because patient numbers are low
- **No country alone** has the knowledge and capacity to treat all rare and complex diseases.
- **Important delay in diagnosis** because lack of knowledge or right referral systems
- **Lack of diagnostic capacity** (no tests available) and treatments in many cases

The Executive and Council of EACMFS have approved the creation of a structure for the impulse, support and coordination of these projects.. Members of EACMFS would participate targeting the following objectives:

- Connect all surgeons committed to cooperation projects. Facilitate the networking, exchange of information and experiences.
- Provide visibility to these projects. Spread the importance of solidarity and cooperation for development
- Facilitate the creation and development of new projects
- Facilitate the search for and identify volunteers for projects
- Facilitate access to sources of funding or support for projects
- Advise on the design and evaluation of international cooperation projects in Cranio-Maxillofacial Surgery.
- Identify Centres in Europe that could provide free treatment for patients with complex pathologies that cannot be operated in their countries of origin and can be transferred for treatment.
- Promote training and exchange programmes in Craniomaxillofacial Surgery in developing countries.
- Provide overseas opportunities for European trainees in Craniomaxillofacial Surgery
- Identify centres in Europe where trainee surgeons from LMICs could gain experience
- Collaborate with regional or local OMFS associations in training or healthcare projects.

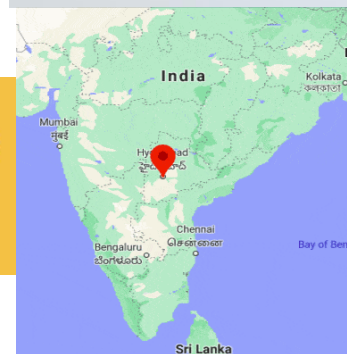
